

As they went and when they went

Many have been called and/or sent by the Lord to do something, but they are playing it safe expecting to see miracles and breakthroughs before they go. I have news for you. If you do not go, you will not see the provision you are believing for and need. Below I examine a few scriptural examples of those who went and received the manifestation of whatever they wanted.

1 Samuel 16:1 And the LORD said unto Samuel, How long wilt thou mourn for Saul, seeing I have rejected him from reigning over Israel? fill thine horn with oil, and go, I will send thee to Jesse the Bethlehemite: for I have provided me a king among his sons.

- a) God did not tell Samuel who the son was until he got to where he was sent. God provided the answer when he was there, not here. Where he was supposed to be. Many times, God will show us fully what we need to see when we obey step one and do what He has asked us to do. Samuel knew it was David when he had gone.

Luke 17:14 And when he saw them, he said unto them, Go shew yourselves unto the priests. And it came to pass, that, as they went, they were cleansed.

- a) The lepers after they cried out to the Lord to heal them, He gave them a word saying, “Go shew yourselves unto the priests” and as they went, they were totally cleansed. The miracle happened as they went.
- b) Manifestation or provision comes as you go—as they went, they were healed.

2 Kings 5:14 Then went he down, and dipped himself seven times in Jordan, according to the saying of the man of God: and his flesh came again like unto the flesh of a little child, and he was clean.

- a) This is about Captain Naaman. This man was a leper and when he received word from the man of God, he did as was told. His miracle did not find him where he was, it came to fruition as and when he went. If he did not go, he could have died a leper.

John 4:50-53 *50 Jesus saith unto him, Go thy way; thy son liveth. And the man believed the word that Jesus had spoken unto him, and he went his way. 51 And as he was now going down, his servants met him, and told him, saying, Thy son liveth. 52 Then enquired he of them the hour when he began to amend. And they said unto him, Yesterday at the seventh hour the fever left him. 53 So the father knew that it was at the same hour, in the which Jesus said unto him, Thy son liveth: and himself believed, and his whole house.*

- a) This man received his prayer request manifestation as he went. The Lord told him to go his way and he obeyed. This could not have been easy, but as he went, a miracle happened.

John 9:7 *And said unto him, Go, wash in the pool of Siloam, (which is by interpretation, Sent.) He went his way therefore, and washed, and came seeing.*

- a) It was after he went his way, One, that he washed, two, and came seeing.
- b) The miracle came as he went or when he went. What could be holding back your miracle is not going and thinking it will happen while you are still here. You have to go!

Luke 22:35 *And he said unto them, When I sent you without purse, and scrip, and shoes, lacked ye any thing? And they said, Nothing.*

- a) In Luke 9:1-6 the Lord called the disciples and gave them power and authority over all demons, and to cure diseases and He sent them out to preach the kingdom of God and to heal the sick. Luke 9:6 *And they departed, and went throughout the villages, preaching the gospel, and healing everywhere.*
- b) *When He sent the disciple without purse, scrip and shoes yet they did not lack anything. They were well provided for although when they went they did not have all.*
- c) Never ever let money be the number one reason you make a decision. Hear from God. Don't let money call the shots. Don't let money be the only major reason you make a decision.
- d) God never calls us because we already have all the resources, we need to accomplish His call. That call almost always comes when we do not have all we need, but as we go and when we go, He provides for all we need.

Matthew 6:31-33 *Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed? 32 (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things. 33 But seek*

ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

- a) We should take no thought. We should not worry. God knows that we need all these things. Rather than worry, we should seek first the Kingdom of God and His righteousness and all that we need shall be added unto you.

Psalms 23:1 The LORD *is* my shepherd; I shall not want.

- a) Because the Lord is our shepherd, we shall not lack. We can go and do whatever He has called us to do without fear of lacking.

Acts 22:10 *And I said, What shall I do, Lord? And the Lord said unto me, Arise, and go into Damascus; and there it shall be told thee of all things which are appointed for thee to do.*

- a) Notice that God was going to speak and reveal directions to Paul in Damascus. Paul had to make his way to Damascus. Is assignment was going to be delivered where he was supposed to be not where he was.
