

## Healing; Three prayers that God won't and can't Answer.

One of the main reasons many people aren't experiencing healing is: the prayers they pray aren't biblical or have no biblical foundation. If you aren't seeing a difference in your results, would you consider changing the way you pray?

There are **three types of prayers** that I understand that God cannot answer.

a) **Asking God to do what He asked us to do**

How should God respond if we are asking Him to do what He told us to do?

- i) Mark 11:23-24 *For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. Therefore, I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.*
- ii) Matthew 10:8 Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give.
- iii) All these verses mentioned above make it clear that we do the healing of the sick and cleanse the lepers and raise the dead—not God.
- iv) It is us to speak to our mountain (Problems).

b) **Asking God to do what He has already done.**

- i) Ephesians 1:3 “Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ:”
  - ii) God **has** blessed us, not **will** bless us or is going to bless us.
  - iii) If you were God, what would you do as if someone asked you to do what he has already done?
- c) **Asking God to do what is against His nature, will, and heart.**

Many times, people pray certain prayers and they believe that it is God that answers them, but that it is not accurate.

I have heard stories of people praying and asking God to give them a disease such as cancer or leukemia, and they got it. So, because they got it, they conclude that it was God that answered that prayer. Nothing can be further from the truth. That is not God who answered that prayer. God would not answer a prayer contrary to His will, heart, and nature.

So, who answers such prayers? I'm glad you asked. It is the devil that answers such sick prayers because he is sick. He takes advantage of your ignorance and brings these evils (poverty, sickness, and diseases) upon you. If you pray for sickness, diseases, poverty and get all these, rest assured it is NOT God who answered your prayer. He wouldn't. **Just because your prayer got “answered,” it does not mean it is God who answered it, especially when it is against His nature, will, and heart.** If it is good, godly, unselfish, and God-exalting, it is God.
