Romans 10:14-18 14 How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? and how shall they hear without a preacher? 15 And how shall they preach, except they be sent? as it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things! 16 But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Esaias saith, Lord, who hath believed our report? 17 So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God. But I say, Have they not heard? Yes verily, their sound went into all the earth, and their words unto the ends of the world.

- a) These passages show that people must hear the Word preached for them to believe hence the need for preachers being sent out.
- b) Whose sound is "their sound" and whose words are "their word?"
- A. Manifest in them

Romans 1:18–21 18 For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hold the truth in unrighteousness; 19 Because that which may be known of God is manifest in them; for God hath shewed it unto them. 20 For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse: 21 Because that, when they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened.

- a) Manifest in them
- b) God has clearly—not vaguely shewed it unto them
- c) The invisible things of God from creation are clearly seen
- d) These things (Eternal power and Godhead) are understood of the things that are made.
- e) People are without excuse

B. Creation

Psalm 19:1-4 ¹The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament sheweth his handywork. ²Day unto day uttereth speech, and night unto night sheweth knowledge. ³There is no speech nor language, where their voice is not heard. ⁴Their line is gone out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world. In them hath he set a tabernacle for the sun, ⁵Which is as a bridegroom coming out of his chamber, and rejoiceth as a strong man to run a race.

- a) Creation is one of the most powerful expression of the existence, omnipotence and the splendor of God.
- b) The heavens declare the glory of God and the firmament shows His handwork. Day and night, it is communicating. This one other way all people get to see and know the Lord.

C. Conscience revealing Guilt

Romans 2:14-15 ¹⁴ For when the Gentiles, which have not the law, do by nature the things contained in the law, these, having not the law, are a law unto themselves: ¹⁵ Which shew the work of the law written in their hearts, their conscience also bearing witness, and their thoughts the mean while accusing or else excusing one another;)

- a) Gentiles have the law on the inside of them written in their hearts.
 - i) They know what is not right through their conscience bearing them witness and their thoughts accusing or excluding another.
- b) Our conscience excuses us or accuses us depending on what kind of things we do—right or wrong and this is true for mankind regardless of their location.

When people from these places that many think have not heard the gospel pursue the Lord, He will reveal Himself to them and give them an opportunity to believe. I have heard that in Muslim nations that some of them get visions when there is no one preaching the gospel directly for them to believe and receive.
