

100% Pure Holy Spirit?

1 Corinthians 2:13 Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual.

- a) Here we see that it is the Holy Ghost that truly teaches. What a minister does is **speak** what God has laid on their heart, but the Holy Spirit will use that to **teach the people**. It is not the Holy Spirit literally speaking.

When we minister, we need to be aware of the truth—we are not 100% God in our communication even though we may be led and inspired by God. One of the misconceptions people have about teaching and the gifts of the spirit is to think they are 100% God and therefore—nothing human in it but that is not true. It's never pure Holy Spirit. God flows through human.

You are all going to say somethings wrong soon or later. God uses us not because of us, but in spite of us. He has no other vessel to use.

Does that then mean you are of the devil because you said something wrong? No! It means you are human. Sometimes you will quote a verse wrongly or be off a little or something. It is not a big deal nor is it that it was not God who was speaking through you.

Your heart, thoughts, motives are from God; but as it goes through your mind and flesh, it gets tainted a little bit. It becomes imperfect, but God still works through it. It will have a certain personality to it and tone of voice to it and so forth.

Because someone misspeaks, he is not of the devil nor is he uninspired; any how we all do.

The gift is from God, but they flow through the human part of you. If you think or believe it has to be 100% Holy Ghost, you will never step out. You will be condemned. You will fear because of the thought that it is not God, but it is—not 100% though.
