- a) Mark 4:38 And he was in the hinder part of the ship, asleep on a pillow: and they awake him, and say unto him, Master, carest thou not that we perish?
 - i) Jesus proved that He cared. Just because He was asleep did not mean He did not care. No one cares more than the Lord.
 - ii) Notice that He had given them a Word or promise to pass over to the other side.
 - o Mark 4:35 -37 And the same day, when the even was come, he saith unto them, Let us pass over unto the other side. 36 And when they had sent away the multitude, they took him even as he was in the ship. And there were also with him other little ships. 37 And there arose a great storm of wind, and the waves beat into the ship, so that it was now full.
- b) Luke 10:40 But Martha was cumbered about much serving, and came to him, and said, Lord, dost thou not care that my sister hath left me to serve alone? bid her therefore that she help me.
 - i) Martha believed that the Lord did not care—care that her sister was not serving with her. This was not true. It is not Jesus who told Mary not to help Martha and it is not Jesus who told Martha to be serving at the very time He was teaching.
 - ii) Jesus cared for these which is why He was in the house.
 - iii) The Lord cares for you. Never believe that He doesn't. This is not accurate. For someone to say the Lord does not care for them is down to either an ignorance or unbelief.
- c) 1 Peter 5:6-7 Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that he may exalt you in due time: 7 Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you.
 - i) We are encouraged to cast our cares upon the Lord because He cares for us. We should rest assured that He cares for us.
