



Words of Eternal life

John 6:67-69 *Then said Jesus unto the twelve, Will ye also go away? [68] Then Simon Peter answered him, Lord, to whom shall we go? thou hast the words of eternal life. [69] And we believe and are sure that thou art that Christ, the Son of the living God.*

Some of you are willing to walk away or give up, but the Lord is saying to whom shall you go? Who is better than the Lord? NONE. Some of you have been through or are going through some difficult times or hardships. Do not go, do not give up, and do not quit.

Jesus had just taught a hard message about eating His flesh and drinking His blood. Many people were offended by this message to the point that some of His disciples (not the 12) stopped following Him.

He turned around and asked the disciples If they were to leave as others had done. Peter responded and His response is very telling. He said, "*Lord, to whom shall we go? thou hast the words of eternal life, and we believe and are sure that thou art that Christ, the son of the living God.*"

- a) Mohammed, Krishna, Buddha, and all these that present other ways do not have "words of eternal life." Only Jesus does.
- b) We should not be going to any of them. We need to stick with the LORD for He is the Christ, the son of the living God.
- c) We need to stick with Jesus. There is no better or equal God. Jesus has no equal. He has no match. All hope in this life and the life to come is in Jesus—no other.
- d) Jesus not only has the words of eternal life, He is the way to eternal life and He is eternal life.
- e) Jesus is the only way. No man comes to the Father without having access through Jesus. We cannot choose how we get to the Father. The Father knows how to get to Him-and He told us how.
- f) We cannot just come up with our own directions to the Father. He alone does have the directions and has given us those directions through Jesus. Jesus is the way (direction) to the Father.
