

## And again! —Look out for a God Repeat

One thing I have seen about the LORD is that He is a God of repetition. He repeats things, miracles, breakthroughs, and to bring help and provision to us. You can believe God for a repeat.

The Lord loves us, and He has done a lot of repeats of good things to communicate His love for us.

We can rest assured that help will come our way if we are trusting and believing God, even if it means a repeat of a miracle.

- ① Feeding the thousands (Matthew 16:9) — Matthew 14:13-21; 15:29-38
- ② Throwing out the money changers—John 2:14-15; Matthew 21: 12-13
- ③ Cast the net to the other side; Luke 5:4-5 (Peter fell down at Jesus' feet, yet not in John 21); John 21:3-12.
  - a) One of the ways we can recognize the LORD is through His works or actions. In John 21:5-7, John knew and had an experience with God that he recognized the Lord as soon as he saw a repeat.
    - i) Repeats from the Lord ought to strengthen our relationship and trust in Him.
  - b) "It is the LORD." Peter did not know the Lord as much as John, while John knew Him at another level.
- ④ Healing them all—Matthew 12:15; Luke 4:40; Luke 6:19.
- ⑤ Touching Jesus and getting healed
  - a) Matthew 9:20
    - i) A woman with the issue of blood for 12 years touched the hem of His garment and was healed instantly.

b) Matthew 14:34-36—Jesus in Genesaret

- i) People took knowledge of Him; they sent out into all that country round about and brought unto Him all the diseased.
  - Besought Him
  - Only touch the hem of His garment
  - As many as touched Him were made perfectly whole. Others also got healed, but it's only those who sought to be healed this way that got healed this way.
- ii) This was a repeat!

### Impact of miracles

- a) John 2:23-24... many believed in His name, when they saw the miracles which he did.
  - i) Miracles open people's hearts to believe on Him. Miracles help make it easier for people to believe and receive.
- b) John 14:11 reveals the same thing.
