

Wisdom of God through speaking in Tongues

1 Corinthians 14:2 "for he that Speaketh in an unknown tongue Speaketh not unto men, but unto God: for no man understandeth him: howbeit in the spirit he Speaketh mysteries."

- a) When we speak in tongues, we speak mysteries.

1 Corinthians 2:7 But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, *even* the hidden *wisdom*, which God ordained before the world unto our glory:

- a) According to 1 Corinthians 2:7, we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery.

Therefore, when we speak in tongues, we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery—**speaking in tongues releases the wisdom of God in our lives.**

We receive a deeper understanding of the things of God. We are mining wisdom in us, out of us.

1 Corinthians 2:5 That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.

- a) The wisdom of men is the opposite of the power of God. Where we have the wisdom of men, there is not the power of God.
- b) The wisdom of men hinders the power of God.
